A member of the health and wellness team will be at a “sign-in” table outside the sanctuary. Please wear a mask. Make sure it covers your mouth and nose. If you do not have a mask, a disposable mask will be provided.

Masks and hand sanitizer will be available.

Please sit in open rows only and maintain a six-foot distance from other congregants.

During the passing of the peace, stand, wave, and greet one another from your seat.

Ushers will advise you when to go forward for Communion. Approach the altar in the center aisle in single file. Please maintain a six-foot separation in line.

Please do not touch other parishioners as you walk past them.

When you reach the altar, hold your hands together, and the priest will drop the bread into your hand. Then return to your seat by the side aisles.

When leaving, please do not gather in the narthex for conversation. Wait until you are outside, and continue following safety protocols.
